- Create your storyboard first by watching the 5 short tutorials on how to create a storyboard in Microsoft Word.
- Complete your Storyboard (with 30 pictures).
- **REMEMBER: Save all your photos from your storyboard in your Photostory folder in your personal drive...you will need them! (To make it easier, you can name them with numbers: 1, 2, 3, ...)**
- Click the Photo Story tutorial link on this page and open the tab named “Training Tutorials”. Watch all 16 videos before you create your own Photo Story.
- Watch the "Setting up the microphone.mp4" video to the right, or in the s drive.

- **Photostory only works when it detects a working microphone: Therefore each time you want to work with PhotoStory you must set up the microphone BEFORE you open the program.**
- Your final project in Photo Story is to be 2 minutes in length (within 5 seconds, example: 1:55 or 2:05, no shorter, no longer) and include all your sources (not counted in the 2 minutes).

- Choose some effects for some of your pictures
- Choose some music for your presentation
- Practice narration prior to recording to ensure it has a polished finish and is **less than 2 minutes**
- Narrate your story. Be sure it is free of mispronunciations, stammers, and long pauses.
- Last slide(s) has all sources listed in MLA format - including images, sound and text
- Save your project as a WMV file** type in your Photostory folder and save as FirstNameLastNamePhotoStory
