Panel Formatting

Each panel should have a title that is centered on the column and be larger and bolder than the panel font. The panel should be formatted for full justification (see the Paragraph group of the Home tab). Each panel should have enough text to nearly fill the column so choose broad topics that do not require too much text. Each panel should also have a picture. (be sure to save the urls so you can list your sources on panel 5). Also – be sure that your brochure is on a word document formatted in landscape orientation and that you do not use text boxes or a template.
