

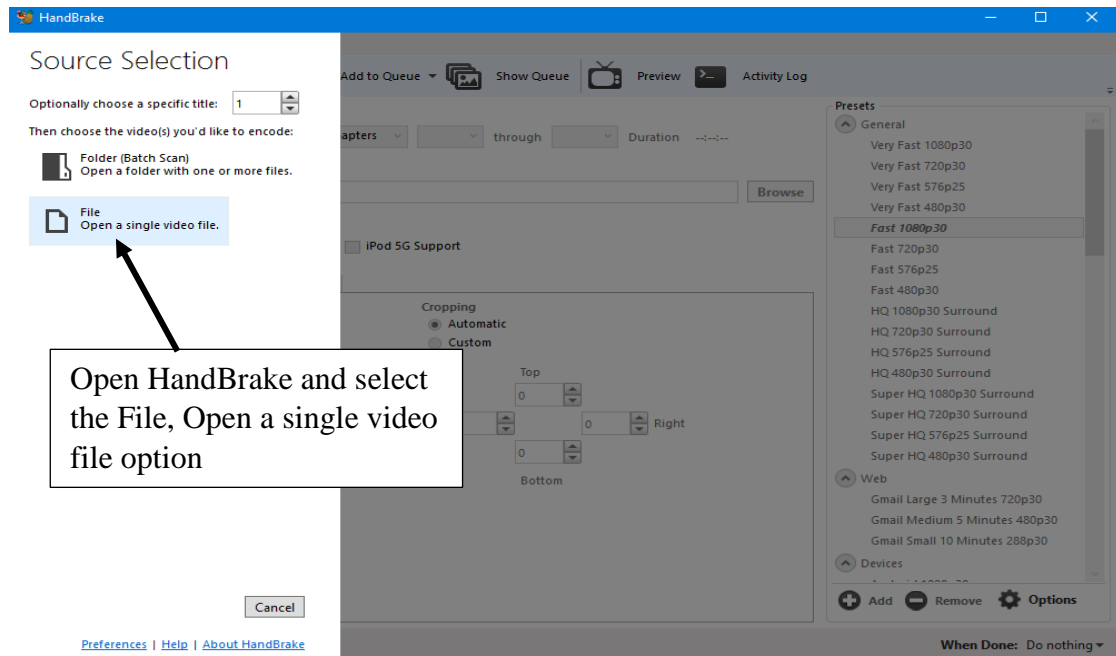
Converting Video format using Handbrake

Open the Handbrake program by double clicking on the desktop icon

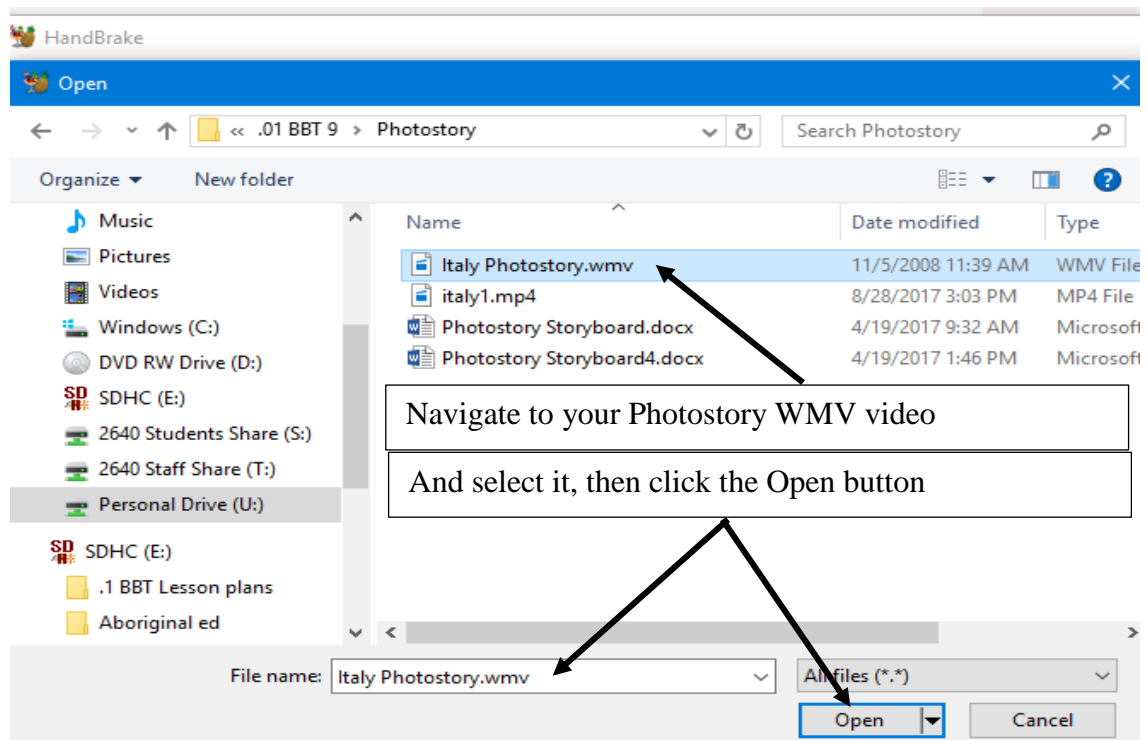
Or by typing “Handbrake” in the search windows



When the program opens, select the File, Open a single video file option as shown below



Then find the file you want to convert and click the Open button as shown below.



Then choose the location you want to save the new file to (your PhotoStory folder), ensure the settings are correct, then click the start encode button, as shown below,
